Objective

Project Titles

Digital Map of My Community

Use Google Maps (or Google My Maps). Mark at least 5 important places near your home (temple, shop, school, hospital, park, mall etc). Add a small description and (if possible) a photo or short video. Save and share/email the map link or the screenshots.

Digital Diary of My Vacation

Write a short digital diary (major days of celebration like Ghatasthapana, Fulpati, Dashami etc.) in Google Docs/Word or on paper first and type later. Add photos, drawings, or short videos about how you spent your vacation. Title: 'My Festival Vacation 2082'.

Problem & Solution Presentation

Find a small real-life problem in your locality (waste, traffic, water, pollution, security etc). Make a digital poster or slide (using Canva or PowerPoint or google slides). Show one technology-based solution.

Example: 'Using an app to report garbage collection.'

Photo Story – 'Festival in My Family'

Take 5–10 photos and/or short video during vacation that tell a story.

Arrange them in Google Slides/Canva/ Capcut with captions. Example: 'Preparing Sel Roti,' 'Lighting diyos,' 'Visiting relatives.' “Visiting temple’ etc. You may also use CapCut (free version) for editing video blogs or photo stories.

Short Animation or Video

Use apps like Toontastic / Powtoon / Scratch (laptop) OR make a simple recorded video. Topic ideas: My Dream School, Festival Celebration, Technology in 2050 or any topic of your choice. You may also use CapCut (free version) for editing video blogs or photo stories.

Interview an Elder

Ask your parents/grandparents about how they celebrated festivals in the past vs. now. Record it (audio or video) OR write their answers in slides. Add photos or drawings to make it creative.

Digital Poster – Digital Nepal / Smart Lalitpur

Design a digital poster (Canva, PowerPoint, or drawing + photo). Theme ideas: Smart Lalitpur City, Digital Nepal 2082, How technology helps students.

Submission

- Be ready to present in class (2–3 minutes).
